



Governor Wolf Receives COVID-19 Vaccine Booster Shot

Harrisburg, PA – Governor Tom Wolf today received his third dose of the COVID-19 vaccine at the Family First Health Center in downtown York, where the governor has received previous vaccinations.

“I am proud to get my COVID-19 vaccine booster shot today and I encourage everyone eligible to get the vaccine and booster, too,” said Gov. Wolf. “The vaccine is safe, effective and free. The best way to put this pandemic behind us is for everyone to get vaccinated. If you’re eligible for a booster shot then make an appointment. It could save your life and the lives of those around you.”
